Policies you should be aware of

Health Form: Camp Piankatank requires a health history form for attendance. This form requires information from a physical performed by a physician in the past 24 months. If parents refuse the physical, or a physician's signature is not available, they must sign a waiver authorizing their child's health. This form is turned in upon arrival for camp.

Group Registration Guidelines: (a group is defined as several people that are not all in the same family but are paying together, like a church group) We prefer to accept checks for group payments. Please include with group checks a list of each person and how much to allocate towards each person. Groups should still follow payment policy.

Payment Policy: All payments must be paid in full by June 1st, 2010. **If registering before June 1st, 2010-** Option 1) Pay in full when returning this form. Option 2) Just send the \$50 nonrefundable deposit, which **must** be included with every registration form. Without the deposit we will not process your registration. The remainder of your balance will be due June 1st, 2010. If you have given us a credit card number your remaining balance will be automatically drafted on June 1st unless we receive alternative payment. **If registering after June 1st, 2010- You must pay in full (including deposit and camp fee) to complete your registration.**

Refund and Cancellation Policy: all cancellations must reach Camp Piankatank three (3) weeks prior to the scheduled arrival date in order to receive a refund of the camp fee. After the cut-off date, refunds of the camp fee will only be given in special cases of sickness or death of an immediate family member or *major* unforeseen circumstances. The \$50 Deposit portion of all registrations is ALWAYS non-refundable and non-transferable. Refunds will be issued within 15 days of the approved request and are non-transferable

Track Option Descriptions

Campers choose one track and stay with that track's activities throughout the week. If it's important to you to be with a specific friend make sure to sign up for the same track. If a track is full we will contact you for your second choice. You should assume that you are in the track you have chosen unless we contact you.

In all of our activities our mission is to encourage spiritual, physical, social and emotional growth within a safe and exciting, Christ-centered environment.

Outdoor Outburst- The active and energetic will love all kinds of sports activities in this option. Specific activities include all kind of sports (volleyball, soccer, basketball, basketball, etc), and adventures on the ropes course (no campout)

Amazing Adventures- Want to do a little of everything? This is a variety of fun and wild activities. Specifics include lots of activities like craft, swimming, archery, games, ropes course, climb the rock wall, canoeing, and the island campout

Water Adventures- The perfect option for adventurous water lovers. Learn to canoe and kayak with ease, plus camping!

A Skill Level Program- All skill levels voyage on a thrilling offsite campout trip

Basic level: canoe and kayak techniques and several exciting trips, knot tying, and learn to plan a campout with assistance
Intermediate level (Must have attended basic level previously): learn canoe and kayak advanced techniques, fun canoeing and kayaking trips, orienteering, and plan your own campout

Advanced level: (Must have attended intermediate level previously): learn canoe/kayak rescues, backpacking skills and more advanced trips

Extreme Escape (13-17 year olds, week 5 only) - "Get away from everyday life and escape to the variety of adventures in this extreme escape for our older campers." Specific activities include: Ropes course, kayaking, sports, archery, just hanging out with friends, and the island campout.

Sailing Camp (13-17 year olds) - Camp Piankatank sailing camps have blown campers away for generations. Come learn the fun of sailing on the beautiful Piankatank River.

A Skill Level Program- All levels include a thrilling sailing overnight trip on our cabin boats

Beginning level: learn about parts of a sailboat, sailing knots, wind direction, and gear. Then learn to sail small sailboats like Snarks and Sidewinders

Intermediate level (Must have attended Beginning level previously): review sailing basics then learn to sail the larger catamarans and cabin boats

Advanced level (Must have attended Intermediate level previously): includes a quick review, then sail catamarans and cabin boats until your heart's content, these campers also learn leadership by assisting younger campers
